The competition will start at 11.00 a.m. Romanian time at the headquarters of the Regional Office for Cross-Border Cooperation Timisoara, Romania, on **19 August 2016** having the following 4 sections:

- Written knowledge test – in English
- English-Romanian translation test
- Computer operating skills - practical test
- Interview

Deadline for submitting the application folder: 17 August 2016, 17.00 Romanian time, at the headquarters of the Regional Office for Cross-Border Cooperation Timișoara, Proclamația de la Timisoara Street No. 5, Timișoara, Timiș County, Romania. **Candidates will be informed of their eligibility and the participation in the competition until 18 August 2016.**

REQUIREMENTS:

- University degree with diploma/certificate (accredited university and course) in the fields: economy, engineering or similar;
- Very good knowledge of the English language;
- Very good knowledge of the Romanian language;
- Good knowledge of the Serbian language will be an advantage;
- Excellent computer operating skills;
- Availability for travelling both in Romania and Serbia;
- Driver's license;
- Relevant work experience of minimum 1 year *could be an advantage*.
